On May 24, the NNTAC Board of Directors and Elders Advisory Group got together in Norseman for the second instalment of our strategic planning over our PBC's future direction.

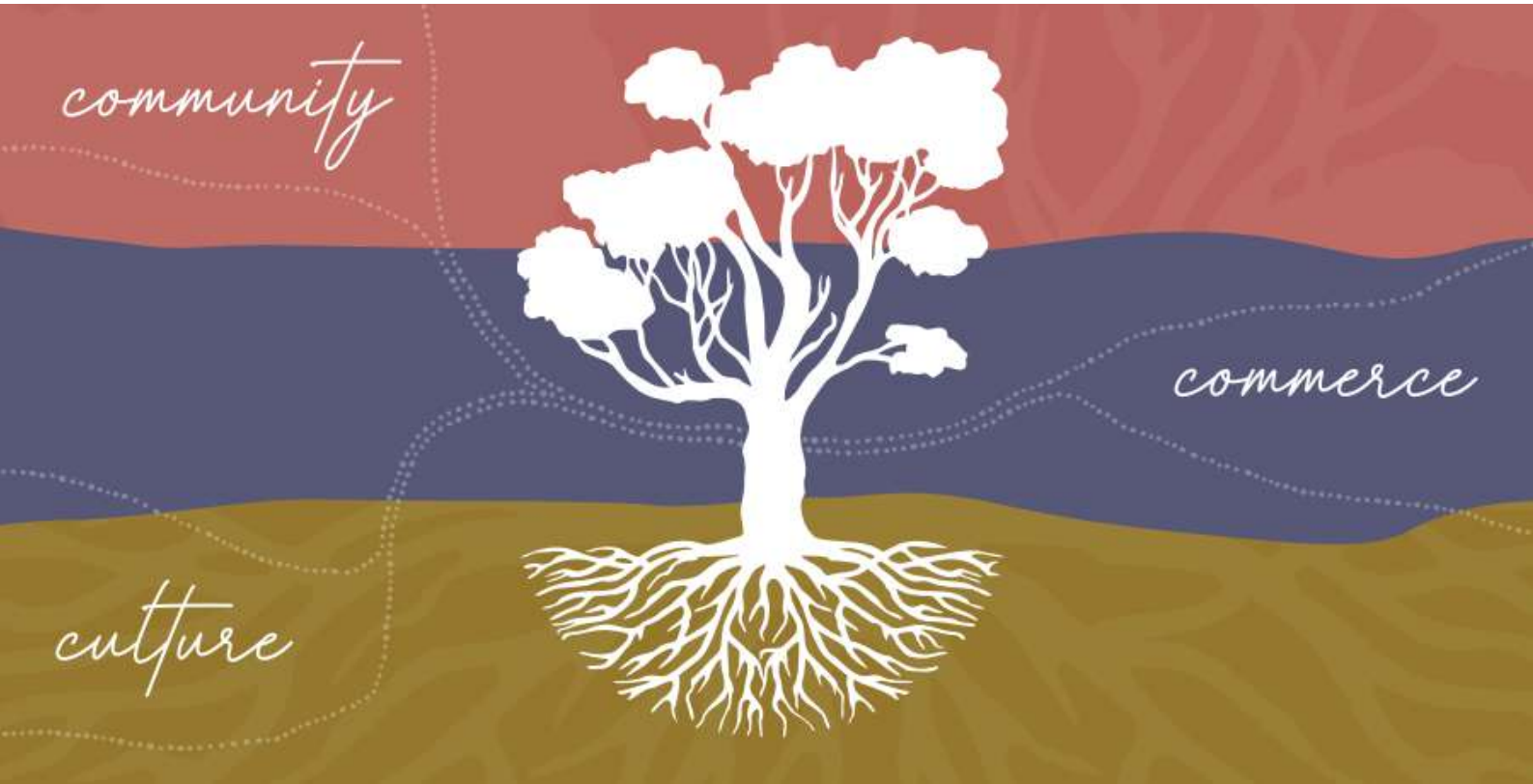
It was a great day of Ngadju working together, supporting future visions for the following core focus areas:

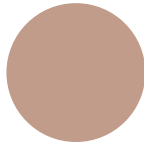

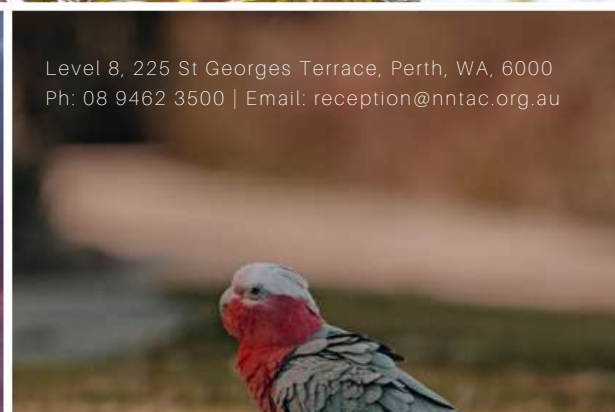
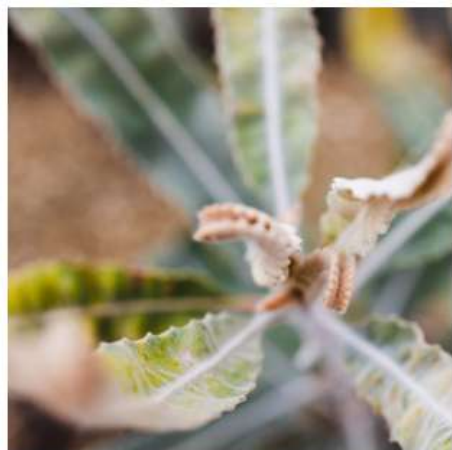
