Expression of Interest Heritage consultants – archaeology and anthropology

Ngadju Native Title Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC (NNTAC) is the prescribed body corporate that holds the native title rights and interests on trust for the Ngadju people. The Ngadju people's native title rights and interests, including the right to maintain and protect important places, were recognised by the Federal Court of Australia in 2014 and 2017 (**Ngadju Determination**).

NNTAC intends to apply to the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Council to carry out the functions of a Local Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Service under the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2021* (Western Australia).

To assist NNTAC in carrying out these responsibilities, we are seeking to expand our panel of heritage consultants and invite expressions of interest (EOI) from suitably qualified anthropologists and archaeologists, and consulting firms who engage such professionals. Consultants must demonstrate in their EOI relevant experience working with native title holders in the conduct of cultural mapping or heritage surveys.

Please provide:

- Relevant academic and professional qualifications and affiliations
- Referees – working with native title holders
- Schedule of professional fees
- Insurance certificates of currency for public liability and professional indemnity
- Sample publications and reports
- Information about intellectual property policy (if available)
- Information about risk management policy (if available)
- Expected capacity in 23/24 and when you would first become available.
- Information about any particular field of research or geographical areas of interest and whether your EOI is limited to those.
- Particular experience on Ngadju country.

Selection criteria

- Experience working with Aboriginal people
- High level of communication skills
- Hold a valid drivers licence
- Field staff hold a first aid certificate
- Experience in archaeological fieldwork (if applicable)
- Experience in ethnographic fieldwork (if applicable)
- Interest in and aptitude for working in Ngadju country



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- Experience in cultural mapping, archaeological excavation, monitoring and lodging applications for registration of heritage sites is desirable
- honours or postgraduate qualifications in archaeology and/or anthropology is desirable
- A good understanding of the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2021* (Western Australia) or ability to quickly develop an understanding is essential.
