SUMMARY

> Kubale Constructions was contracted to build the Control Building of the Tarago Water Treatment Plant. With a contract value approximately \$2.0m, works included a fully equipped kitchen, staff amenities, bathrooms, a laboratory testing room for water quality, server room, control room, meeting room and various offices. In total, the building footprint was over 500 sqm surrounded by mixed architectural claddings and complex cantilevered canopies. To finish, Kubale Constructions completed the fit-out with furniture and office fixtures. On time, on budget.
