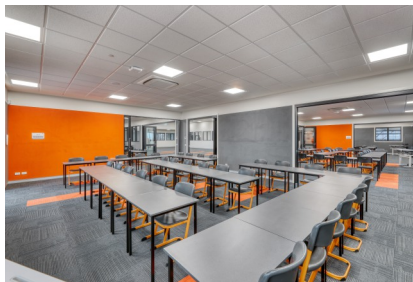


# PROJECT PROFILE

### SUMMARY

> On time and on budget ... actually early ... much to the client's delight. Operating within a live site, we cordoned off the dilapidated basketball courts and began work to construct the expansive enclosure. The scope then included 4 new classrooms, a staff room, 3 offices and a Yr 12 study area along with amenities. The courts were resurfaced, remarked and new sporting equipment was installed as part of the refurbishment. All rooms were clad in Exotec and fully detailed by our staff including floor coverings, glazing, lighting, joinery and technology installations.
