DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO PLAY SPORT FOR THE SCHOOL?

All students are expected to actively participate in the College's co-curricular program. Students participating in co-curricular Sport at the College are required to adhere to the following expectation when joining a team.

Students selected for a College sports team must meet all commitments to these teams – training and performing. On enrolment at Marcellin College, students and parents understand that their enrolment involves a commitment to the co-curricular life of the school. The commitment is for the entire time the student is at the school and not just for the first few years. Therefore, if the student chooses to participate in a sport in the community that is also offered at Marcellin College, it is expected that the student will represent Marcellin College, if required by the school.

COACHING

All teams are allocated a coach at the start of the season which is a Marcellin College staff member.
