Learning Diversity primarily focuses on supporting students with identified learning needs.


Members of the Learning Diversity Department:

- Adopt a holistic approach in supporting the student in their learning

- Identifying and overcoming barriers to learning
- Setting realistic targets for the next stage of learning
- Identifying teaching and learning support to help students achieve their learning goals while taking into account the student's cultural, social and health circumstances.

We are committed to ensuring your child's learning experience is tailored to suit their individual needs.





Staff in our Learning Diversity Department develop and implement programs to support the continuous improvement of skills across the curriculum for students with individual needs. These programs may involve individual students, year levels, subjects and the whole school. They work primarily with students that are part of the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on school students with a Disability (NCCD).

The team works collaboratively with teaching staff to provide a learning environment for students that acknowledges and supports different needs and skills through focused and targeted teaching.

The team can help teachers adjust tasks and assessments and support teachers and students in the classroom to implement these individual programs.

The aim is to cater to a student's learning requirements to help them succeed academically, socially and emotionally.
