CHALLENGE

"Our staff serve patients suffering from mental health and substance use disorder. Staff members struggle when their expectations for patients do not match the patient's current abilities, and then they feel "disrespected." This (along with other factors) often leads to compassion fatigue. We wanted a way to hear from our "customers" and our staff, so we have Pulse For Good kiosks in our patient-facing locations."

SOLUTIONS, BENEFITS & RESULTS

"It has given the patients a safe way to share serious concerns as well as heartfelt gratitude. People express what they are feeling in the moment. Here's an example: our staff were expressing concern about their ability to provide a specific service in a timely manner. Our patients were also expressing concern. [After processing feedback from Pulse For Good's kiosks], they are now considering doubling that staff in order to be more efficient."
