They are generously donated by Memories by Michelle (979-557-3511, 1820 6th St., Bay City, Texas 77414). Appointment times are set aside on September 7-10. Please don't wait to schedule because appointments after those dates may be available but are not guaranteed.

2) Contestant Introduction - Your 100-word introduction should be emailed to the Pageant Director at rrix90@gmail.com on or before September 27, 2023. Information must include name, parents, sponsor, and school. Introduction may include hobbies, clubs & organizations, special awards, and future plans. This should be written in third person and must not exceed 100 words.

3) Entry Fee - You should find a sponsor to pay the \$225 entry fee. Your sponsor will be listed in the program and announced during the Pageant. This can be an individual person, like a family member, or a business. Please include the entry fee with your entry form. We might be able to help find a sponsor if necessary.

4) Entry Form - This should be filled out and submitted on or before September 27, 2023

Thursday, October 12, 2023 - Rehearsal- Location To Be Determined

5:00 pm- 7:00 pm Rehearsal in the theater.

This rehearsal is important for all contestants to attend! We will walk through the entire order of the pageant, including introductions, stage positioning and back stage responsibilities. This is also your chance to practice the modeling walk on the stage.

Saturday, October 14, 2023 - Queen's Tea - Bay City Country Club

10:00 am – 12:00 pm Queen's Tea and Contestant Interviews

Business Attire - The tea is an opportunity for the contestants and the club to get to know each other. The public is invited. During the tea, the judges will choose the Most Photogenic and complete interviews.

Each contestant will spend up to five minutes with the judges. Contestants must be present until after group photos have been taken and their Miss Congeniality vote is cast.

QUALIFICATIONS AND POLICY STATEMENT

1. The contestant must be a single female, not have been married or had a marriage annulled, had no children, and must remain single during her reign or forfeit her crown.
2. The contestant must be a full time high school senior, must be younger than 21 years old, as of December 1, of the pageant year (2023) and must be a resident of Matagorda County or attend high school in Matagorda County.
3. **The contestant must have a sponsor to pay their \$225 Entry Fee.** The sponsor may be a civic club, business, non-profit organization, or individual. Each contestant's sponsor will be listed on materials such as the Rice Festival program and during the Queen's Pageant. **We can assist you in finding a sponsor if needed.**
4. A completed **Entry Form with the entry fee** must be received on or before **Wednesday, September 27, 2023.** Entry fee: \$225 (payable to the Bay City Lions Club)
5. A **Contestant Introduction** should be emailed to the Pageant Director at rrix90@gmail.com on or before September 27, 2023. Information must include name, parents, sponsor, and school. Introduction may include hobbies, clubs & organizations, special awards, and future plans. This should be written in third person and **must not** exceed 100 words. Introductions not meeting these criteria may be edited.
6. Any entry received without photos and entry fee will be considered incomplete and will be returned.
7. **Photos required** (Color, shoulders or bust only – no profiles). – All pictures must be taken by Memories by Michelle (Contact at 979-557-3511, 1820 6th St., Bay City, Texas 77414), **BEFORE September 27!** Please do NOT wait until the last minute to make your appointment to get your picture taken. Time has been set aside each day between September 7-10. No other dates are guaranteed to be available.
8. The contestant must be of good moral character and never have been convicted of any crime, with the exception of Class C traffic offenses.
9. If the contestant violates the Controlled Substance Penal Code Act, she will be disqualified from this contest.
10. It must be understood that there will be no financial remuneration for transportation expenses to and from Bay City.
11. Former Bay City Lions Club Rice Festival Queens and Contestants are ineligible.
12. The contestant must attend all functions that are listed as required on an information sheet to be provided to all contestants.
13. It is required that the contestant ride in transportation provided for her in the Bay City Lions Club Rice Festival Parade, on the following Saturday, October 21, 2023.
14. The contestant that is crowned Queen of the Bay City Lions Rice Festival must be available to attend any public event for festivities to represent the Bay City Lions Club during the year that the Club deems necessary.
