Course overview

Schools are highly complex organisations. This demands skilled and knowledgeable teams of leaders who are ready and willing to work together to solve the challenges that inevitably arise. In doing this, they must lead improvement and more importantly, build trust.

This course is a practical, researchinformed workshop series designed specifically to address these imperatives.

ightarrow Who will benefit from this course

GGL[™]2 is for leaders who face a challenge in their school and want to improve outcomes for students. This course is aimed at educational leaders, such as:

- Principals
- Deputy, Associate and Assistant Principals
- Heads of Department
- Heads of Faculties
- Senior Teachers
- Team Leaders
- Pastoral Leaders.

It's ideal if one or more members of the leadership group completes GGL™1: Leadership Essentials so that they have a solid theory background. This type of learning is most valuable and has the greatest impact when a team of three or more from a school attend together.

ightarrow Learning outcomes

GGL[™]2 challenges leadership teams to work together to identify, and progress a significant student-centred improvement priority from their school. Course content includes strategies that enable teams to:

- Identify a significant, student-centred improvement priority in their own school
- Undertake causal inquiry and solution design
- Implement and monitor the solution, making iterative adjustments as appropriate.

\rightarrow Course structure

GGL[™]2 is delivered over a period of 15 weeks and is designed to scaffold relevant theory and rich examples to promote the development of high level knowledge and skill.

This course is delivered as a blended mode of face-to-face and online learning. You can choose to undertake this course as a group with your school leadership team, or as an individual learning opportunity alongside other school leaders.
