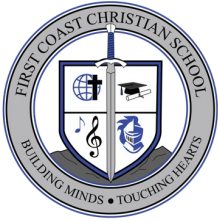


# Destination: Graduation

### High School Timeline

#### 9th grade

Visit [www.bigfuture.org](http://www.bigfuture.org) and create a student account to plan for high school & beyond.

#### 10th grade

Ensure that all credits have been earned.

#### 11th grade

Dual enrollment for students with high GPA & pass the entrance test for FSCJ

#### **Take the PSAT/NMSQT**

Identify colleges interested in attending & their entrance requirements

#### 12th grade

**Fall**– Apply for colleges and scholarships

Retake the SAT or ACT

**Spring**– Complete the FAFSA ([www.fafsa.org](http://www.fafsa.org)) for financial aid. **Bright Future Students** must also complete the FFAA ([www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org](http://www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org))

A cumulative GPA of at least a 2.0 will also be required.

(To be considered for a Bright Future's Scholarship a student will need at least 75 hours of community service and maintain a 3.0 GPA.)
