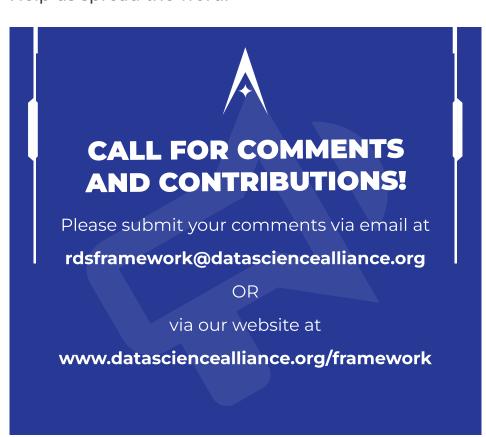

# The Responsible Data Science Framework

A major milestone for DSA and the Responsible Data Science (RDS) Movement. More than a year in the making, we were thrilled to publish the first public draft of our RDS Framework on February 15, 2023. Conceived to be an ever-evolving tool to guide organizations and data professionals in implementing responsible practices in their work, it is meant to be a shared resource for our community. And its scope is beyond just a single industry! The expertise of the framework's contributors covers a wide range of fields — including academia, government, tech, and healthcare. Since its publication, we have been reaching out to our community for their comments and feedback. The first round of public review ends on March 31, 2023. ### The Food Bank Project

Collaboration in service to our community. An exciting update to the Food Bank Project: After months of development, the predictive model and dashboard for food assistance in San Diego County were delivered to stakeholders in early March 2023. We have received the initial user acceptance feedback and we are on schedule for final deployment in April. A partnership with Feeding San Diego and the Jacobs & Cushman San Diego Food Bank, the Food Bank Project has been a powerful inspiration for collaboration and the practice of Responsible Data Science. For example, since February 2023, the contribution of our grad students (pictured below) from the University of San Diego -Knauss School of Business has proven integral to keeping us on track and achieving our Q1 goals.
