


## **Role of Active Listening**

#### Checklist of active listening concepts:

- ✓ Makes eye contact with each other
- No one interrupts a speaker until finished with concept or idea
- ✓ Ask 2 questions to understand what each speaker said
- ✓ Ask for clarification from speaker if necessary
- Repeat the concept or idea that the speaker conveyed

Active listening does not require anyone agrees with what was said, but what was said was heard, understood, and considered.
