





### Programming issues or system logic updates or clarifications

Element impacted: Project Exit Date (3.10)

Change: If Auto-Exit features exist (though not a requirement), holding Vendors to a set of minimum criteria to ensure DQ in national datasets would coincide with the instructions in the Manual for "CoCs to be part of the determination of excessive length" since last activity, and would standardize what activity is used as "last" (bed night, service, etc.)

HoH requirements


Elements impacted: Relationship to Head of Household (3.15) and HouseholdID (5.09)

Change: Increase alignment between Dictionary and Manual regarding HoH changes, management, and logic. There may be only ONE HoH.

Aging into adulthood

Elements impacted: Income and Sources (4.02) and Non-Cash Benefits (4.03)

Change: Address concerns with how to record income and benefits for people aging into adulthood while participating in project. Treat income updates at 18 as "Updates" and make Income/NCB at Entry \$0.



## Programming issues or system logic updates or clarifications

Element impacted: Housing Move-in Date (3.20)

Change: More alignment between Manual & Dictionary regarding Housing Move-In Date management and logic. For example, Housing Move-In Date can only be on or between Project Start Date and Project Exit Date for each enrollment.

Data Collected About clarifications


Element impacted: T-Cell and Viral Load (W4)

Change: Improve consistency between HOPWA elements for "data collected about". Changed language to align with W3 and new W6. "All household members with HIV/AIDS" (instead of "Only Clients funded in a HOPWA project presenting with HIV/AIDS")

Pregnancy Status

Element impacted: Pregnancy Status (R10)

Change: Remove limitation of applicability to only "female" participants to be more inclusionary and allow people who identify with any gender to respond.
