## Top tips for successful native planting



## Tip #1: Control pests and weeds before planting.



Consider... Don't waste time and money planting until you've controlled pests like deer, goats, wallabies and hares.
These pests will destroy your new plants!



**Decide your goal for pest control.**Try to collaborate with neighbours and other farms nearby so that your work has more impact.

## Tip #2: Maintenance after planting is key to plant survival.



**Maintaining moisture** - Use weed mat or mulch, plant during wet times of the year, and irrigate if practical.



**Weed and protect** - Young plants are vulnerable to pests and weather. Release young plants from weeds by hand pulling or spraying. Plant sleeves provide protection from weather and herbivores.
