COOKIE POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 We are Seventh Sense Artificial Intelligence Private Limited, a company registered in Singapore having the Unique Entity Number of 201902751E with our registered office at 30 Cecil Street #19-08, Singapore 049712 ("we" or "us"). We operate the websites https://www.seventhsense.ai/and https://developer.opencv.fr (the "Websites").
- Our core face recognition service is a software-as-a-service technology, which customers subscribe to from our Websites. These technology services can be accessed by:
 - A. logging in through any of our Websites;
 - B. downloading our Agent7 mobile app (the "App"), and logging in to our services module;
 - c. using our software development kits ("<u>SDKs</u>") to access our API; or
 - D. using our HTTP REST API from a programming language of your choice.
- 1.3 By accessing and using our App, Websites, SDKs and the services provided therein (the "Services"), whether in connection with a paid subscription, free trial, promotion or otherwise, you must be of legal age and willing to be bound by the cookie practices described in this Cookie Policy.

2. COOKIE POLICY TERMS

- This Cookie Policy explains how we store cookies in accordance with our obligations under applicable privacy and data protection law, including Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (the "GDPR"), the UK Data Protection Act 2018, and the Singapore Personal Data Protection Act (collectively, "Applicable Data Protection Law")
- 2.2 The storage of our cookies is based on Art. 6 (f) of the GDPR. We have a legitimate interest in this service in order for us to:
 - A. recognise you when you sign in to use our Services;
 - B. display features, products, and services (including ads for products and services available on our Websites and App or otherwise), which might be of interest to you;
 - C. keep track of items saved in your shopping basket
 - D. prevent fraudulent activity;
 - E. improve security; and
 - F. understand how customers use our Services so we can make improvements.

- 3. INFORMATION WE COLLECT THROUGH COOKIES
 - 3.1 Examples of the information we automatically collect through cookies include:
 - A. Network and connection information, such as the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer or other device to the Internet and information about your Internet service provider
 - B. Computer and device information, such as device, application, or browser type and version, browser plug-in type and version, operating system, or time zone setting
 - C. The location of your device or computer
 - D. Authentication and security credential information
 - E. Content interaction information, such as content downloads, streams, and playback details, including duration and number of simultaneous streams and downloads
 - F. The full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) clickstream to, through, and from our Websites and App (including date and time) and our offerings, content you viewed or searched for, page response times, download errors, and page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs)

4. MANAGING COOKIES

4.1 Cookie Preferences On our Websites and App: Our cookies allow you to take advantage of some essential and useful features. Blocking some types of cookies may impact your experience of our sites. You can change your cookie preferences at any time by clicking Cookie preferences in the footer of our Websites.

4.2 Browser Settings:

- A. You can manage browser cookies through your browser settings. The 'Help' feature on most browsers will tell you how to remove cookies from your device, prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie, how to disable cookies, and when cookies will expire. Check the support site for your browser to understand privacy settings available to you.
- B. If you block or reject some of our cookies through your browser's settings, you might not be able to use certain offerings that require you to sign in to an account and some features and services may not work. You might also have to manually adjust your preferences or settings every time you use our Services. If your browser includes Intelligent Tracking Prevention (ITP), preferences specific to our sites may reset on an ongoing basis. These resets are managed by your browser, not by us.

4.3 Third Party Cookies:

A. Approved third parties may also set cookies when you interact with our offerings. Third parties include search engines,

providers of measurement and analytics services, social media networks, and advertising companies. These third parties use cookies in the process of delivering content, including ads relevant to your interests, to measure the effectiveness of their ads, and to perform services on our behalf.
