Norman conquest

Just a few kilometres from the hustle and bustle of Deauville, the newlyopened four-star hotel Les Manoirs des Portes de Deauville sits in a peaceful, five-acre park. The hotel includes a manor house, nine cottages, an orchard and a pond, a relaxation area with a pool house, an outdoor heated pool, a sauna and a Jacuzzi, making it the perfect getaway to relax and unwind, as well as enjoy everything the region has to offer.

Each room, suite or cottage is simply yet stylishly decorated, and some have their own kitchenette as well as views of the garden. The hotel also has a cosy honesty bar, designed to look and feel welcoming thanks to its interior, which blends velvet with cane work and black wood and features bistro tables encircled with brass. For some extra cocooning during colder nights, small lounges are set around a large central fireplace. In the morning this space transforms itself into a breakfast room, where traditional French pastries and breads, as well as seasonal fruits and local produce, are served.

The hotel's exposed beams and authentic Norman half-timbered and thatched exterior are reminiscent of its rich history. The building, which is a 16th- and 17th-century manor and a registered historical building, was formerly called Le Manoir de Prétot and belonged to Marie Corneille, the sister of 17th-century French dramatist Pierre Corneille.
