A Career In Gaming



A career in the gaming industry doesn't have to be about just playing games. There are careers that do involve this, but there is so much more to it! Some careers in gaming include:

- Game designer: Video game designers develop the concept, storyline, characters, dialogue, as well as all the rules of the game. Designers determine how difficult the game should be, as well as what kind of obstacles the player will encounter.
- Concept artist: Early in the development cycle, concept artists work with art directors to shape the look of a video game before it enters production. Concept artists use photographic research, 3D modelling, and digital painting to create the initial look and tone of the video game.
- Game artists: Animators, 3D artists, and visual effects artists are all responsible for developing the look and feel of the in-game assets. Sound designers and audio engineers are also integral to the process, as they will create all the sounds that are heard in-game, from the opening theme to the sound effects of the menu.
