1. Application Form: Prospective students must complete the school's application form. 2. Application Fee(\$250): An application fee to cover administrative costs associated with processing the application.
2. Academic Transcripts: Academic transcripts or report cards from their previous school(s).
3. Passport : A valid passport as proof of your identity and nationality.
4. English Language Proficiency: International students need to demonstrate proficiency in English. It can be replaced by an interview.
6.2 pieces of Art Portfolio (Only If you would like to apply to Art Major Colleges/Universities): Submit an art portfolio showcasing your creative abilities and artistic potential. Freeform, Including drawings, paintings, sculptures, photographs, digital artwork, or any other relevant medium.
5. Virtual Interview: To assess their artistic abilities, interests, and fit with the program. This interview also include an English speaking check to evaluate the student's communication skills.

## CANADIAN CITIZENS \& PERMANENT RESIDENTS STUDENT:

1. Application Form: Prospective students must complete the school's application form.
2. Application Fee(\$250): An application fee to cover administrative costs associated with processing the application.
3. Academic Transcripts: Academic transcripts or report cards from their previous school(s).
4. Proof of Permanent Residence or Citizenship: Documents such as a Canadian passport, birth certificate, Care Card (Medical Services Plan - MSP) Certificate of Canadian Citizenship, or Permanent Resident card.
5. 2 Pieces of Art Portfolio (Only If you would like to apply to Art Major Colleges/Universities): Submit an art portfolio showcasing your creative abilities and artistic potential. Freeform, Including drawings, paintings, sculptures, photographs, digital artwork, or any other relevant medium.
6. Virtual Interview : To assess the student's artistic abilities, interests, and fit with the program.

## THE B.C. CERTIFIGATE OF GRADUATION



The BC Dogwood Diploma is the high school graduation diploma awarded to students who successfully complete their secondary education in the province of British Columbia, Canada. It is named after the official provincial flower, the Pacific Dogwood.

The Dogwood Diploma is recognized by post-secondary institutions and employers in British Columbia and across Canada.


## The graduation requirements for the BC Dogwood Diploma includes the following components:

1. Credits: Students must earn a minimum of 80 credits, which are awarded for completing specific courses throughout their high school years. These credits are distributed across various subject areas, including English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Physical Education, Fine Arts, Applied Skills, and Electives.
2. Required Courses: Certain courses are considered mandatory for graduation. These typically include English language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, and physical education. The specific courses and number of credits required may vary slightly depending on the school district.
3. Elective Courses: Students have the flexibility to choose elective courses based on their interests and career aspirations. Elective courses allow students to explore various subjects and deepen their knowledge in specific areas.
4. Graduation Transitions: Graduation Transitions is a required program that focuses on personal and career development, community involvement, and transition planning for life after high school. Students complete a portfolio and participate in activities related to personal health, community engagement, and career exploration.
5. Provincial Assessments: Students are required to complete certain provincial assessments, including the Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment and the Grade 12 Literacy Assessment. These assessments evaluate students' skills and knowledge in specific areas.
