## Year 7 DRAMA

## **Overall Intent:**

In Year 7 students study a variety of pieces of work that are thematic or skills led – working in a non-verbal manner to start with, working towards use of voice in performance. Within each piece of work there is an emphasis on creating, responding and performing. In doing so they build the understanding to explore how drama has a place in the Arts world and within the wider approach of building confidence skills. They develop skills in performance and presentation within the schemes of learning. These are built on in Year 8 when we will begin to study more complex thematic ideas and theatre history. By looking at a range of performance skills, themes and starting points and developing a wide range of performance skills, students develop their ability to respond, to think and to be able to articulate their ideas. They are also developing skills to be confident young people in their ability to talk, discuss, plan and prepare for presentation.
