## Year 11 GERMAN

## **Overall Intent:**

In Year 11, GCSE students develop further their knowledge of German, building on the key language and grammar introduced in the first three or four years. The key topics are travel, holidays, local area, the world of work and the world around us. The content is carefully layered to facilitate progression in terms of sophistication and length of response. Language is taught in a very structured way initially, and where context permits, greater independence is encouraged. Key grammar is consolidated throughout, and more complex grammar is introduced to higher candidates.
