Since we are on a schedule to get every camp in on time, we need you to be at the pre-arranged base camp on time. You will need to abide by the load restrictions that are outlined below. The number of pack animals available to you is based on the number of people in your group and the type of camp that you are booked for. Loads **WILL NOT** exceed 60 pounds per side and 30 pounds on top. Rubbermaid type containers of same size (20 – 25 gallon) made of flexible and durable material is recommended.
