

Court Booking Rules

Our intention with the booking rules is to provide all members with the opportunity to book courts AND to maximize court use.

A member may have:

- 1. Up to 2 court reservations per day
- 2. Up to 8 court reservations per week
- 3. Up to 1 prime time reservation per day
- 4. Up to 2 prime time reservations per week
- 5. Up to 3 reservations in the future
- 6. You can book your court 7 days in advance, starting at 9:00 AM
- 7. **NEW!** Last-minute bookings: If a court is available 3 hours before your start time, you can book it even if you have maxed out the restrictions described above.
- 8. **3 last-minute cancellations** will result in a suspension of your booking privileges for 1 week. A last-minute cancellation is within 4 hours of the reservation start time.
- No-shows: It is disrespectful to other members to reserve a court but then not show up. If you
 cannot make it to your reservation, cancel it. 2 no-shows will result in a suspension of your
 booking privileges for 1 week.
- 10. **Guests:** Each member is allowed 2 guests per month. The guest fee is \$15, payable online by credit card when you make your booking.

Prime Time Hours

Sat and Sun: 8 am – 12 pm

Weekday evenings: 6 pm − 10 pm

Public Hours

Friday: 5-7 pm, 8-10 pm

Sunday: 8-10 pm

As always, non-members have priority during Public Hours. Members cannot make reservations, but members can come to the courts and play under the same rules as non-members.

And the part when I sound like your Dad...

Compared to the old days (pre-2020), when you would just show up at the courts and hope that one was free, a booking system is an enormous convenience. But it only works if members are thoughtful and respectful. Don't bend the rules and remember to cancel your reservations.
