I am very happy to report another groundbreaking year for Fresh Start! Through the efforts of our all-volunteer board, we were able to raise the highest amount of money in the history of the organization!

This is a result of the incredible generosity of grant organizations which include the Laffey McHugh Foundation, Fund for Women, Incyte Charitable Giving Foundation, Milton and Hattie Kutz Foundation, Draper Holdings Charitable Foundation, Eliason Education and Greening Fund, and SoDel Cares Fund, as well as our over 30 annual event sponsors which are listed on the following pages. I'd like to give a big shout out to Sandy Scheibe and Mary Maloney for driving these efforts.

In addition, we were able to attract a number of new donors due in large part to our annual event committee headed up by Marisa Facciolo, who so effectively marketed the event to a whole new audience.

As a result, we will be able to fund 22 returning scholars and 18 new scholars in the 2023-2024 academic year that will bring our total scholarship dollars awarded to \$1.59 million.
