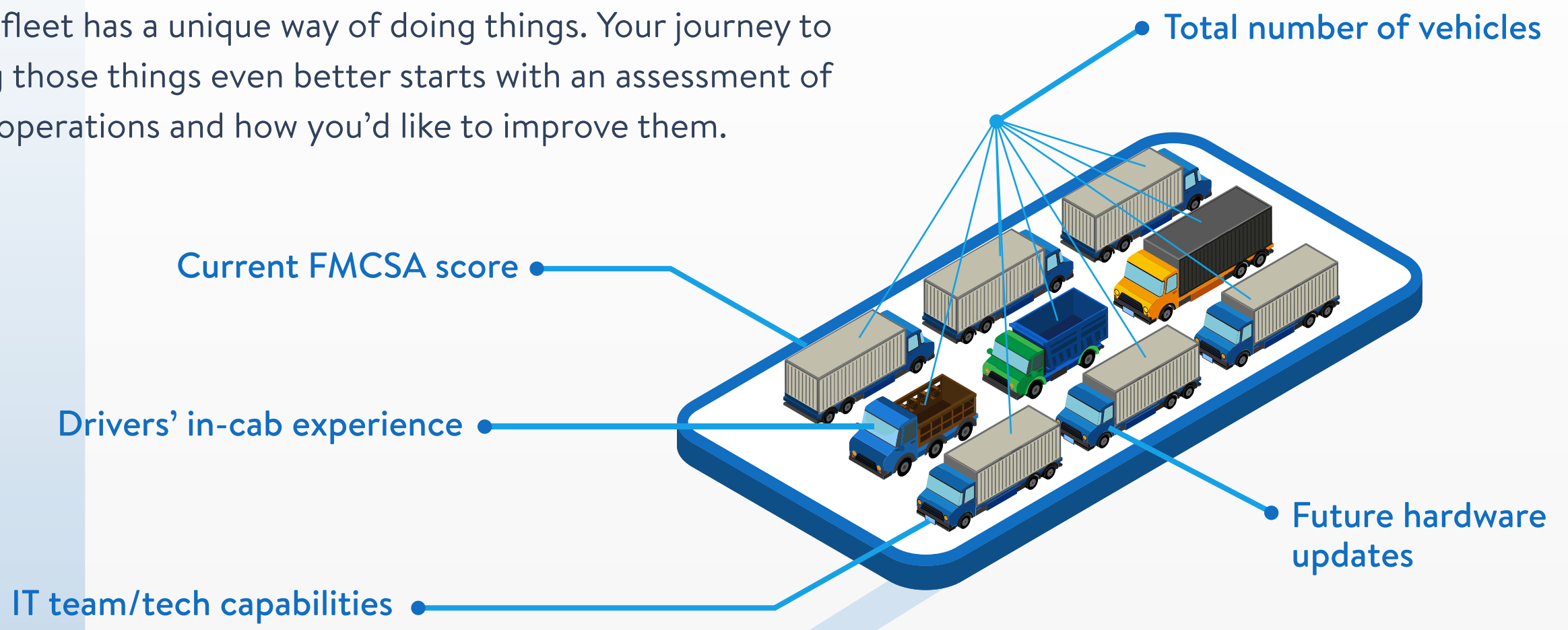


The four steps of fleet change management

Whether you're considering an upgrade to your fleet's current technology or simply want to know what the process looks like, here's what you can expect from a telematics transition

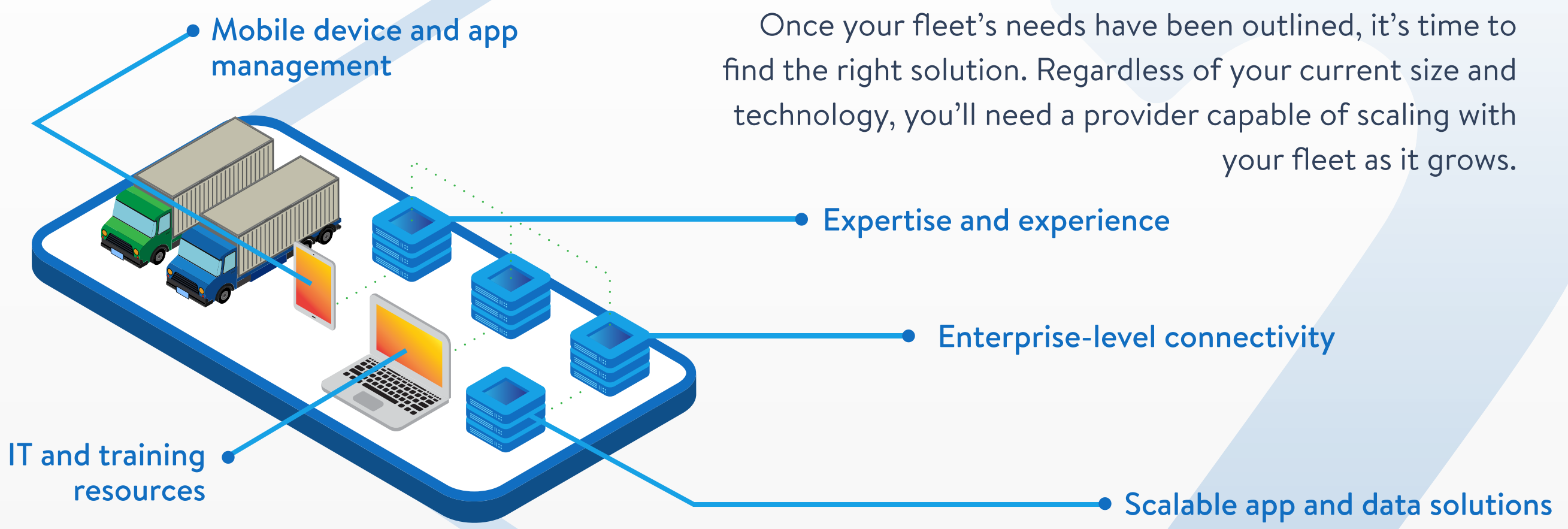
1. Identifying your fleet's needs

Each fleet has a unique way of doing things. Your journey to doing those things even better starts with an assessment of your operations and how you'd like to improve them.



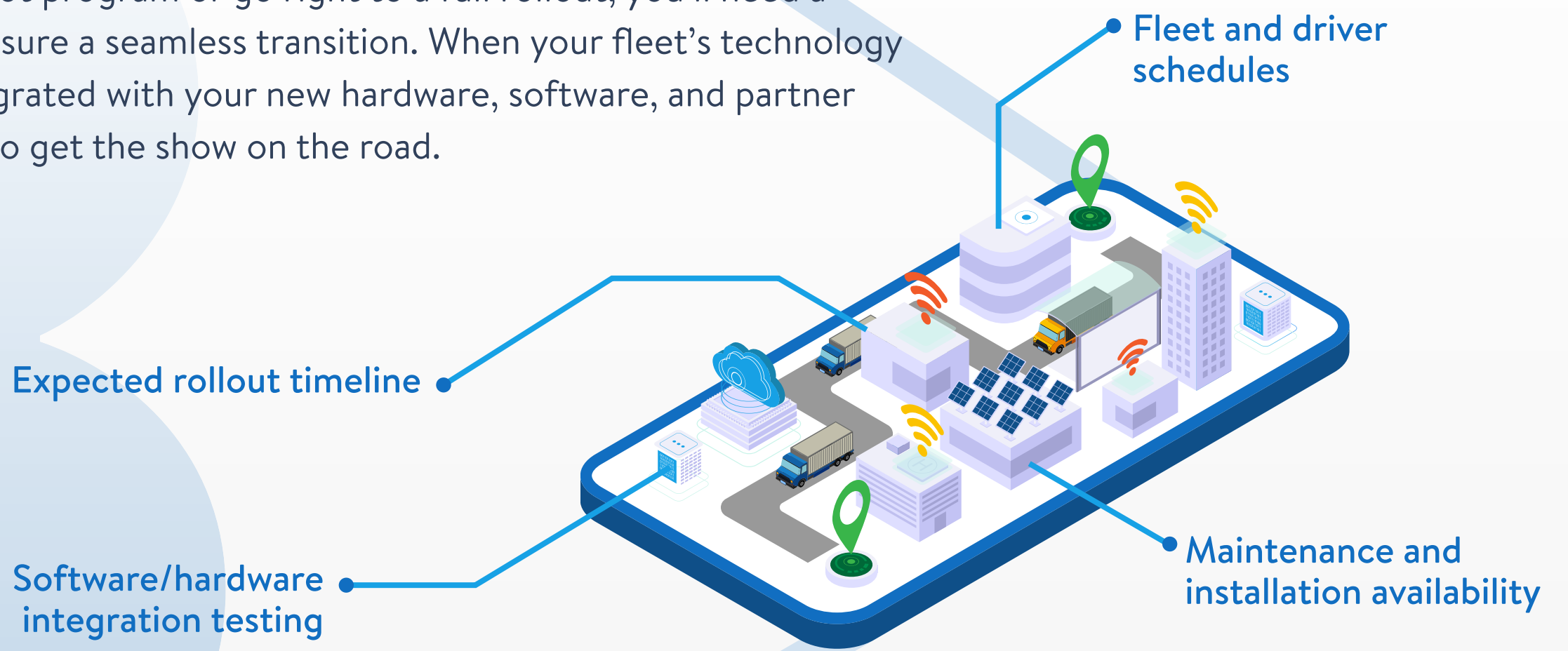
2. Considering your options
