The following skills are aspects that we would expect the children to be using in their writing, mostly independently, to be able to reach age related expectations.

To include the correct punctuation in writing (<u>A</u> . ? ! , in a list)

To use capital letters for the start of sentences and for proper nouns

To use a range of conjunction (FANBOYS / A WHITEBUS)

To use past and present tenses accurately

There/their/they're e.g. Over <u>there</u> is a tree. <u>Their</u> shoes are on the floor. <u>They're</u> training for the running race.

To use expanded noun phrases within writing

To use consistent joined handwriting
