

Secretary Report 2022

Membership and Communication

One key aim this year is to increase PTA Membership to support the existing members. A drive needs to be done to ensure that all the new parents to the school are aware of us. An idea suggested last year was to have a board on school grounds with all the information and upcoming events so parents are always aware. Social media has become ever more important but the reach is not always assured.

We've found that communication is incredibly important and even with social media and letters, a lot of information still does not find its way to the parents. The key is consistency and repetition. We need to ensure that social media posts are clear and precise and that the information is shared in a variety of ways (posters / social media / letters). There was a new mailing list that parents can join to be alerted to events and activities but this has had very little takeup and will need to be pushed this year..

New Direction / Expansion

It's been a bit more back to normal this year with events running as before. We still took Covid into consideration and adjusted as needed. Sweets for example, were set up 72 hours in advance to reduce cross contamination risks. We also introduced a new event - the Valentine's Disco which was a huge success and we plan to continue.

This year, we have also started to take the charity into a more ethical direction. We have reduced the small plastic prizes and stocked up on larger prizes that are won with a token system. The initial trial was successful though to make it more so, we will need to find a format for games as well as add new ones.

One of our key aims continues to be to increase the PTA membership. We need to ensure that the message is received that it does not necessarily need to be a 'full time' job but any help that can be received at any event would be gratefully received. We have the three main positions filled and are lucky to have found very dedicated members for these roles but they are very time consuming in themselves and we could really do with support for event planning and running.

And hopefully this year we will be able to complete the Sensory Garden and continue our fundraising for the MUGA.
