



Swillington Primary School Outcomes for 2022-2023

The 2017 assessments for KS1 and KS2 are the second year to assess the new, more challenging national curriculum introduced in 2014. Pupils now receive a test result as a scaled score and a teacher assessment based on the standards in the interim framework. Because of the changes, these test results are not comparable to the previous national curriculum level outcomes.
