About the project

The Lead IT, Lady! program prepares women in IT for leadership roles, supports female leaders in developing their competencies, and opens the door to a flourishing community of women in the technology industry.

The program combines workshops and mentoring and offers an opportunity to earn hands-on experience in real-life projects.

It helps participants discover their strengths and challenges them in various ways to unlock their potential.

The program lasts 9 months and consists of 4 modules
