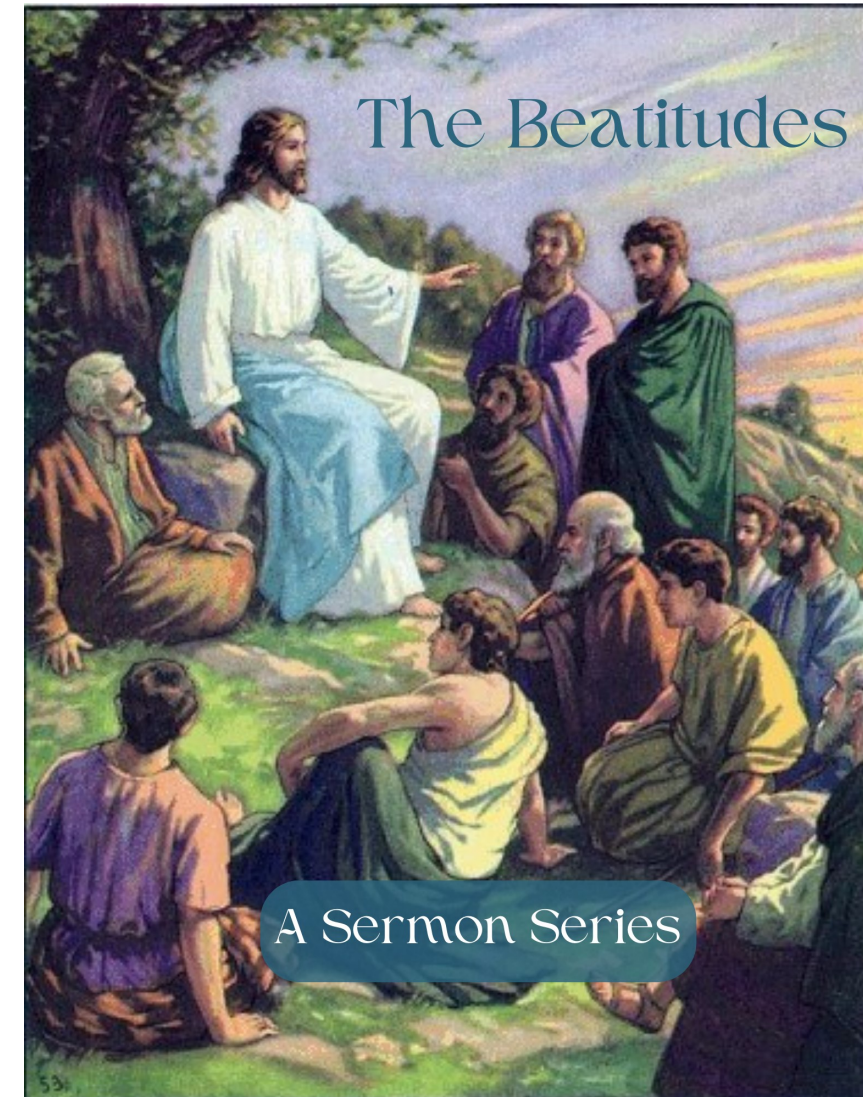

Prayer with the Pastor
