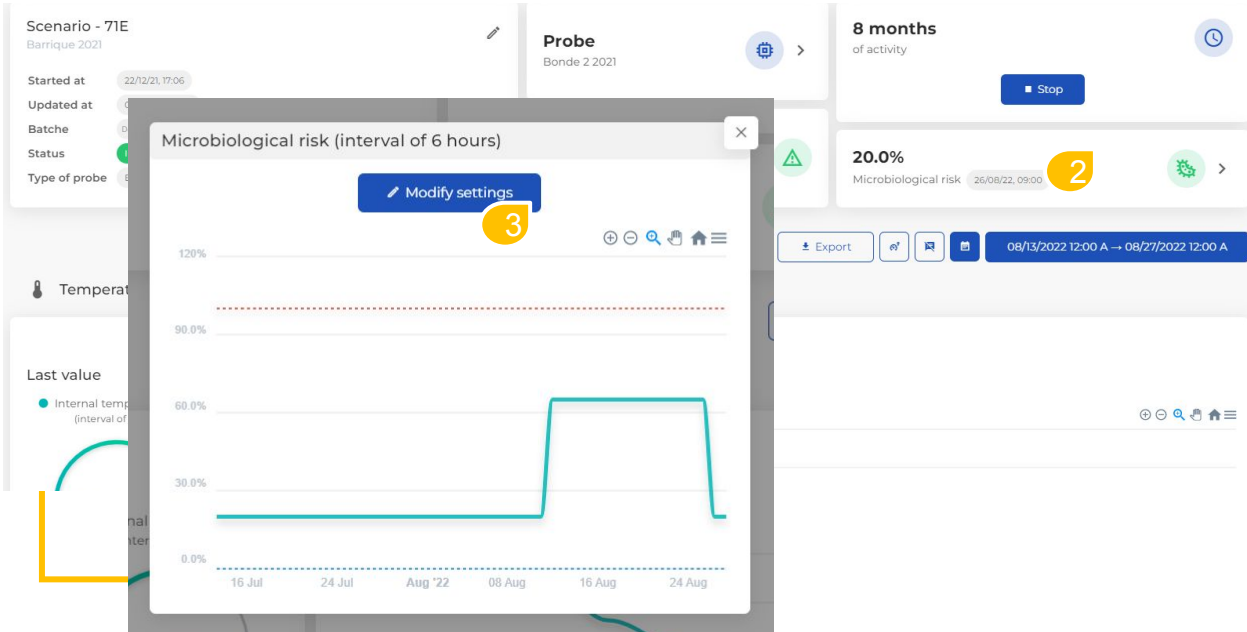
# Risk of microbiological departure gauge
