Pine Hurst Drive – Extend from Tebeau St. to E. Blackshear Avenue


Thigpen Road – Pine View Rd. to Lovett Rd.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lucas to adjourn the Called Meeting at 10:19 a.m., with Commissioner Pope seconding the motion.


The motion passed unanimously.
