
LAJC - INTERIM REPORT (Dec. 2022 - Feb 2023)

Youth Hannukah Celebration in Buenos Aires


(Dec) 50 young leaders in the Buenos Aires community gathered to share a chill Hannukah celebration for our Next Generations program.




