Solve each tricky two-step word problem and find the letter for each answer in the table to solve the riddle like a word problem wizard!

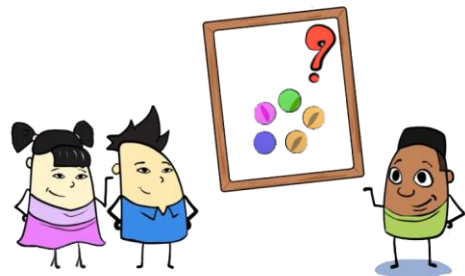
1. There are three classes in the third grade at River Middle School. If each class has 21 students and there are 5 teachers, how many people are in third grade in all?



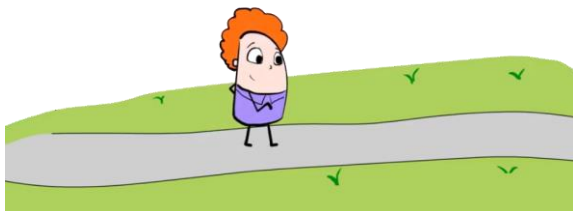

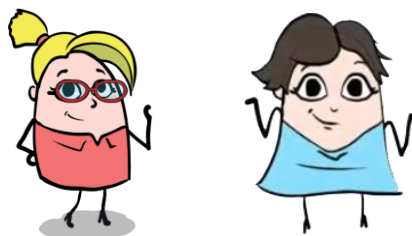
