

Butterfly lifecycle necklace

Materials



green construction paper



scissors



hole punch



three varying pastas (macaroni, bowtie, penne, etc)



markers/watercolors /food coloring



varn or string



paper or plastic straw




glue

Instructions

- 1. Cut four leaf shapes from the construction paper.
- 2. Dye or color the pasta shapes using the markers or watercolors.
- 3. Using the hole punch, punch a circle out of paper to represent the egg.
- 4. Cut the straw into three equal pieces.
- **5.** On each leaf, label with the name of each butterfly cycle: egg, chrysalis, caterpillar, butterfly
- **6.** Glue the pieces that represent each cycle on the corresponding leaf: the white circle is the egg, the rotini might represent the caterpillar, the bowtie might best represent the butterfly
- **7.** Once glue and paint is dry, it's time to start assembling the necklace. The straw will act as spacers. It should go: egg, straw, caterpillar, straw, chrysalis, straw, butterfly
- 8. You have created a fun and versatile visual representation of the life cycle!
