The BABS degree (**122** credit hours) offers students several options to choose from. Associate of Biblical Studies

The Associate of Liberal Arts (**ALA**) degree program is an interdisciplinary program of study that provides a broad exploration of the ideas, values, issues, and heritage of civilization. 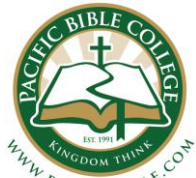

ASSOCIATE OF EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

The Early Childhood Education Program (ECE) prepares students for the vocation of an early childhood professional. ECE professionals work with children from infancy to 8 years old in preschools, day care centers, Head Start or other child development facilities. The role of the ECE professional is to work with children and their families to promote social, physical, and intellectual growth needed for primary school. This associate degree program trains students in all facets of ECE vocation through the lens of a biblical worldview. At the completion of the program, students may apply for a Child Development Associate (CDA) level 9 credential through the Oregon registry.

ON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THIS PROGRAM STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO:

1. Develop and articulate a biblical philosophy of education as a foundation for their teaching.
2. Analyze, create, and implement development goals and learning strategies based on a child's needs.
3. Promote childhood development and learning.
4. Demonstrate an ability to integrate biblical truth, learning theory, and knowledge of human development in an ECE professional role.
