



#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

- What should I know before I register?
- What do you look for in suppliers and subcontractors?
- What you can expect with the registration process:
  - Register for a username and password. You'll receive a login ID, temporary password and a link to our registration system, via email.
  - Follow the link and log in to the system to complete the registration form/submit. You'll receive an email confirming receipt of your registration.
  - Validation process: 3-5 business days after submission of your registration and receipt of your signed W-9.
  - Email confirmation validation.
