# We use the following Cookies

- Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Website and Platform. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our Website, use a shopping cart or to make payments.
- Analytical or performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website and Platform when they are using it.
