Guntersville is located on the southernmost point of the Tennessee River, surrounded by 69,000 acres of water. There is almost a thousand miles of shoreline, you don't go far without a view of the tree-lined lake, and the most beautiful mountain-lake sunsets you will find anywhere. Guntersville offers the amenities of a larger city plus the friendliness and charm of a small town.

River Ridge Retreat provides a serene backdrop for the Spring Rally, boasting both mountainside views and over a mile of waterfront on Lake Guntersville.

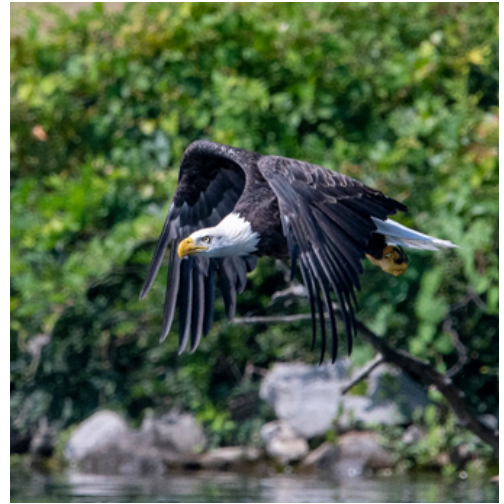
The property offers 54 pull-through RV sites (72' long x 40' wide) with full-hook up (30 amp & 50 amp service), and 12, modern tiny house cabins (should anyone not have their coach with them). All sites include a grill and fire ring, RV sites include a picnic table as well.

The expansive property sits on over 670 acres, featuring hiking and biking trails, fishing from the banks or large pier, and abundant wildlife.

SATURDAY, JUNE 8

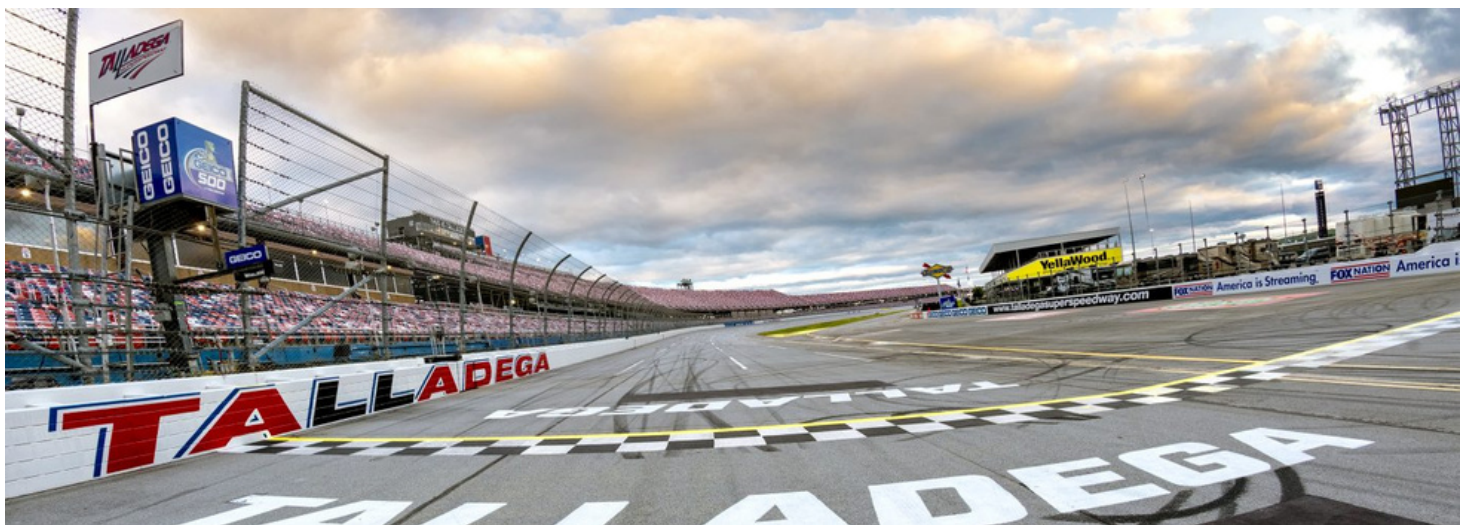
Ride

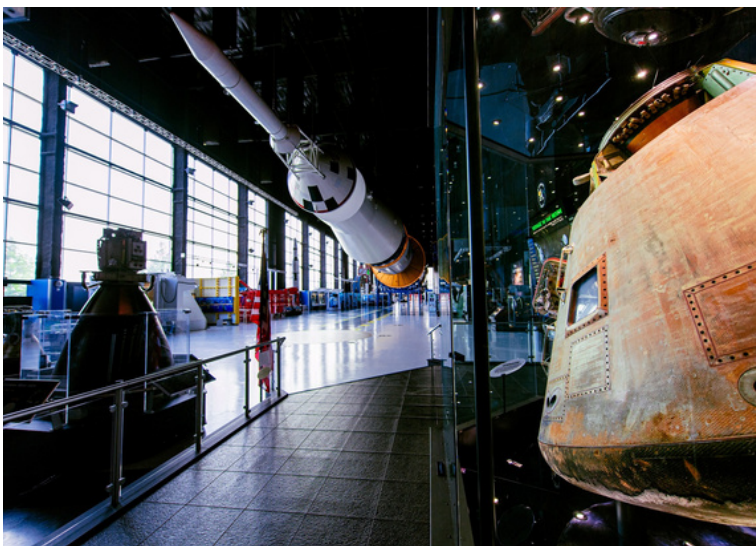


THE SCENIC ROUTE

Your first course is a visit to Mr. Jack's Distillery along with a flight of fine Tennessee whiskeys and liqueurs then, just as Mr. Jack did more than a century ago, you'll feast on country fare at for lunch at Miss Mary Bobo's Boarding House. Your return trip will be "out of this world" with a stop at the U.S. Space & Rocket Center, in Huntsville, AL. From America's first satellite, Explorer I, to next generation space vehicles like Sierra Nevada's Dream Chaser, the Space & Rocket Center showcases the past, present and future of human spaceflight.

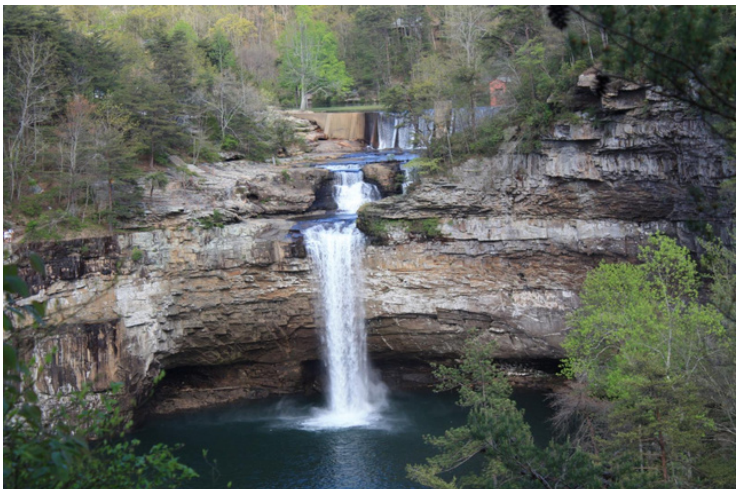
LOOKOUT MOUNTAIN WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12
