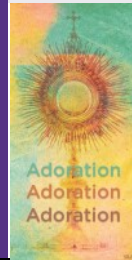

My name is Andrew Vickery, and I am a seminarian for the Diocese of Birmingham – which means that I am studying to be priest for our diocese. I grew up just north of Atlanta in Roswell, Georgia. I was baptized and largely grew up in the Methodist Church, and in 2013 my mom, brother, and I were received into the Catholic Church. After high school I began studying civil engineering at the University of Alabama. Civil engineering was a passion of mine for a long time, and it was with great joy that I graduated in 2020—though the Lord had plans for me that were different from practicing engineering.

After graduating Alabama, I entered seminary at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio where this spring I finished my third of six years of formation. By entering seminary, I was responding to several small promptings of God over a number of years. These promptings took the form of what I would call small tugs on my heart and little thoughts about the priesthood that would not go away. I would like to encourage any of my fellow young people here to seriously consider what the Lord might be calling you to and to not be afraid of taking a next step in following Him – following Him who never deceives us and always has our best interest in mind.

This summer I have been assigned to your parish and I look forward to getting to know y'all, working with y'all, and learning from y'all.
