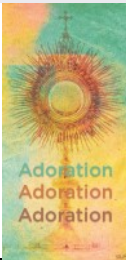

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We come this weekend to the Feast of Pentecost, the conclusion of the Easter season. Or maybe to put it a bit better, the *fulfillment* of the Easter season, when the mystery of Jesus' Resurrection changed the lives and hearts of the disciples. With their experience of the sacraments of the first Easter, they received the Holy Spirit, and they began to preach Christ to the world.

I think we're at a similar point of transition here at St. Thomas in 2023. We've been celebrating the new presence of Jesus' Cross and Resurrection to so many people in so many ways for the past couple months: about 100 disciples confirmed, and about 120 young people receiving First Holy Communion. Not to mention many baptisms (about 85 in the past year!), and the People of God gathering each week to continue experiencing what Christ has done for us. And now we come to the end of Easter.

Before we head out into the long, green season—Ordinary Time, the time of the Church and the time of our mission—we gather to be renewed by the power of the Holy Spirit. I'd ask you to join me in praying for his power and guidance for our parish over the coming months:

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. Enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created, and you will renew the face of the earth. Amen!
