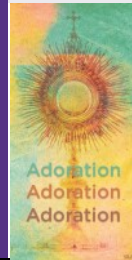

And finally, to celebrate a great year here at the parish and to ask God's blessing upon our community, we will be once again be honoring our patron saint, St. Thomas, on the Sunday closest to his feast day. This year, that will fall on July the 2nd. To help us observe the occasion as a community, we'll also be having a parish picnic that day, after the 11am and 12:30pm Masses. 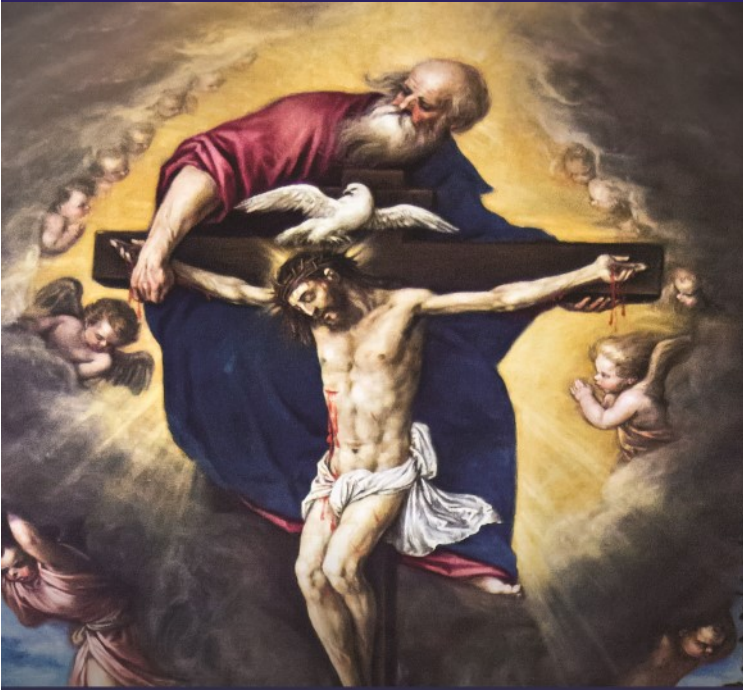
