



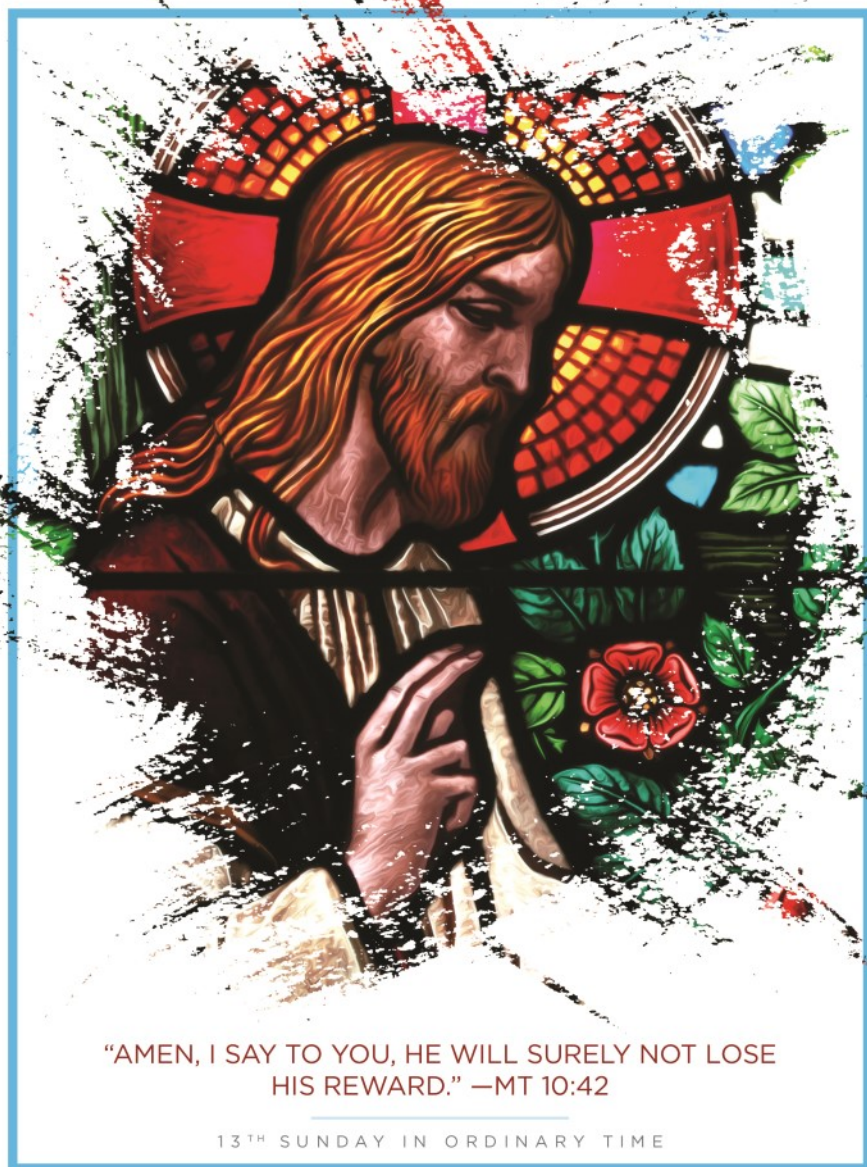

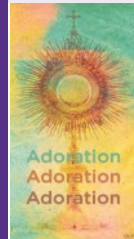

### St. Bernard Preparatory School

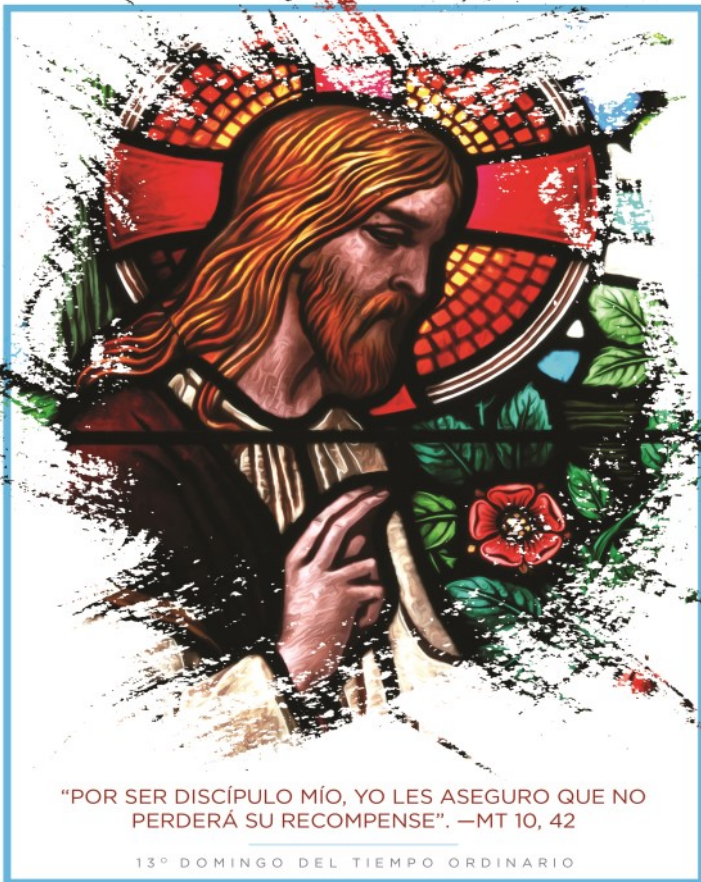
