## Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este fin de semana marca siete semanas que nuestro seminarista de verano, Andrew, ha estado con nosotros, y solo le queda una semana más. Ha sido maravilloso tenerlo aquí con nosotros, y aunque estamos tristes de verlo partir, también nos damos cuenta de que necesita volver a sus estudios formales. Si Dios quiere, será ordenado en otros tres años, ¡y asegurémonos de ofrecer muchas oraciones para que llegue allí!

El tiempo de Andrew en la parroquia nos da la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre las vocaciones al sacerdocio. Como todos saben, no son muchos sacerdotes en estos días, y nuestra diócesis necesita mucho más. ¿De dónde vendrán? Es muy simple: los sacerdotes que necesitamos vendrán de nuestras familias y nuestras comunidades. Dios siempre está llamando a los hombres a esta vocación especial; la única pregunta es si ayudamos o no a nuestros hermanos a escuchar y responder a ese llamado.

No solo genéricamente para "más vocaciones", sino específicamente para que Dios allane el camino a los hombres que está llamando.
