

#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Continuing with our reflection on the Last Things, this week I'd like to focus on something we usually don't like to think about: the final judgment. Our Gospel today is the famous Parable of the Talents. In it, three stewards who are each entrusted with part of their master's property while he is away, and upon his return, he judges what each of them have done with it.

Usually when we hear this parable, our minds immediately go to the idea of stewardship and that's very natural! But as we contemplate the Last Things, I think we can also hear an echo of a bigger truth here. I love the words that the Master says to the good stewards: "Come, share your master's joy." Since we are all God's children, every human being has Rosary on Sunday Mornings two possibilities within ourselves. We can be like the good stewards, who grew into what they were made to be: open to the infinite and eternal joys of life with God in heaven. Or in our selfishness and fear, we can be like the unfaithful steward, closing ourselves off from God's love and missing out on what we were made to be.

With the final judgment, we know that God will one day set his seal upon the choices we've The youth group meets in the St. Anthony made. That's a sobering thought. But at the same time, we know that the God who will judge us is our loving Father, and that he's giving us all the assistance we need right now to us. Thank you all for showing that love to me and to everyone who walks through our doors. 

#### Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Siguiendo con nuestra reflexión sobre las Cosas Finales, esta semana quisiera centrarme en algo en lo que normalmente no nos gusta pensar: el juicio final. Nuestro Evangelio de hoy es la famosa Parábola de los Talentos. En ella, a tres mayordomos se les confía a cada uno parte de los bienes de su amo. A su regreso, juzga lo que cada uno de ellos ha hecho con ellos.

Por lo general, cuando escuchamos esta parábola, nuestra mente inmediatamente piensa en la idea de mayordomía, ¡y eso es muy natural! Pero al contemplar las Cosas Finales, creo que también podemos escuchar aquí el eco de una verdad más amplia. Me gustan las palabras que el Maestro dice a los buenos mayordomos: "Entra a tomar parte en la alegría de tu señor". Como todos somos hijos de Dios, cada ser humano tiene dos posibilidades. Podemos ser como los buenos administradores, que crecieron hasta que fueron capaces de recibir el deseo de su corazón: las alegrías infinitas y eternas de la vida con Dios en el cielo. O en nuestro egoísmo y miedo, podemos cerrarnos al amor de Dios y, al hacerlo, perdernos aquello para lo que fuimos creados.

Con el juicio final, sabemos que Dios algún día pondrá su sello sobre las decisiones que hemos tomado. Ése es un pensamiento solemnizador. Pero al mismo tiempo, sabemos que el Dios que nos juzgará es nuestro Padre amoroso, y que nos está brindando toda la ayuda que necesitamos en este momento para convertirnos en personas capaces de recibir la plenitud de su amor.

A medida que nos acercamos a la temporada navideña, estoy profundamente agradecido de que Santo Tomás es un lugar donde tantas personas han experimentado el amor de Dios. Gracias a todos por mostrar ese amor a mí y a todos los que cruzan nuestras puertas. A través de las oraciones de la Santísima Madre y de nuestro patrón Santo Tomás, miremos cada día a la luz de la eternidad y resolvamos seguir creciendo en ese amor. ¡Un bendecido Día de Acción de Gracias a todos!
