Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I pray the New Year is going well for everyone! This Sunday, the Sunday of the Epiphany of the Lord, we join the Wise Men and all nations in worshipping Christ, the Newborn King. Today is the last Sunday of the Christmas season—but as we all know, it's important to keep the joys and message of Christmas alive in our hearts throughout the year.

To help us do so as a community, we will once again be celebrating the beautiful old custom of Epiphany chalk blessings. The first step of this tradition is easy: in the gathering space of the church, you'll find bags of blessed chalk with some prayers. The first step is easy: after Mass today, someone from each family will pick up a prayer card and a piece of the chalk. This is good, honest carpenter's chalk, used for marking out a plan for the project we're working on. What's our parish's project? It's very simple: we're going to live Christmas throughout this New Year.

The second step is also easy: gather your family for prayer, and after you've prayed, use the chalk to write the letters the prayer card somewhere on or near your door: 20+C+M+B+24. It's an abbreviation for the Latin *Christus mansionem benedicat 2024*, which means "May Christ bless this house in 2024." And every time you see those letters, remember the message of Christmas: that the Son of God became man to save us, bless us, and be with us.

May the Lord pour out his abundant blessings upon us in this New Year, through the intercession of Blessed Mary Ever-Virgin and our patron St. Thomas.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

¡Espero que el Año Nuevo vaya bien para todos! Este domingo, la Epifanía del Señor, nos unimos a los Reyes Magos y a todas las naciones en la adoración a Cristo, nuestro Rey Recién Nacido. Hoy es el último domingo de la temporada navideña, pero como todos sabemos, es importante mantener vivas las alegrías y el mensaje de Navidad en nuestros corazones durante todo el año.

Para ayudarnos a hacerlo como comunidad, una vez más celebraremos la hermosa y antigua costumbre de las bendiciones con tiza en la Epifanía. El primer paso de esta tradición es fácil: en la entrada de la iglesia, hay tiza bendecida con hojitas de oraciones. El primer paso es fácil: al final de la Misa hoy, al salir, alguien de cada familia recogerá una tarjeta de oración y una tiza. Esta es una tiza de carpintero, que se usa para planear un proyecto. ¿Cuál es el proyecto de nuestra parroquia? Es muy sencillo: vamos a vivir la Navidad durante todo este Año Nuevo.

El segundo paso también es fácil: reúna a su familia para orar y, después de orar, use la tiza para escribir las letras de la tarjeta de oración cerca de su puerta: 20+C+ M+B+24. Es una abreviatura del latín *Christus mansionem benedicat 2024*, que significa "Que Cristo bendiga esta casa en 2024". Y cada vez que veas esas letras, recuerda el mensaje de Navidad: que el Hijo de Dios se hizo hombre para salvarnos, bendecirnos y estar con nosotros.

Que el Señor derrame sus abundantes bendiciones sobre nosotros en 2024, por la intercesión de Santa María Siempre Virgen y nuestro patrón Santo Tomás.
