

Lenten Fast and Abstinence

On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and each Friday of Lent, Catholics who are in good health and are at least 14 years old are obliged to abstain from eating meat (including beef, pork, chicken, and other animals). There is also an obligation to fast on Ash Wednesday (2/14) and Good Friday (4/7) for Catholics in good health from ages 18 through 59. Fasting for this discipline means only one full meal on those days, plus up to two light meals, but no food in between. Catholics are also encouraged to express interior penance in other ways, especially prayer, corporal and spiritual works of mercy, and charity to those in need.

Stations of the Cross 2/16




