
How does Enrich Education describe their product?



Orienteering

High quality, bespoke maps are created of your school grounds and specific to your school context.







Combined with physical panels (control markers) placed around the school grounds, they provide children with not only an introduction to orienteering but also a vast range (over 350) of stimulating activities to get children active across the whole curriculum. A set of control markers specifically to support phonics is also available.



All the control markers are linked to the cross-curricular activities and are interactive through the use of QR codes, some of which activate a short exercise video clip or link to seasonal activities, for example, audible book extracts on World Book Day.



The downloadable activity plans save teachers' time by being concisely written and easy-to-follow, with objectives, preparation required, National Curriculum links and progression clearly shown.

Quidditch

A key feature of the game is that it involves children having different roles in the game, each with different and specific responsibilities. This makes it fully inclusive and removes the potential for individual children to dominate the action, as can happen in some traditional sports.

A whole-school Quidditch 'event day' includes an assembly, led by two coaches from Enrich Education on the school site. Each class has a Quidditch session to learn the rules, understand the different positions and experience a game, while collecting

points for their whole-school 'house'. Enrich Education describe the sessions as '*fun, but also active and fast-paced*'. Staff are fully involved in the event day.



Enrich Education is the official education partner of QuidditchUK so after an event day, schools can buy the Quidditch equipment. The game fully supports the Key 5 Outcomes, meaning schools can use the PE Premium to purchase the equipment. The 'Introduction to Quidditch' training module includes free session plans and an introductory webinar, all endorsed by 1st4Sport and certified by QuidditchUK. As well as introducing children to a brand new activity, Enrich Education describes how the game often encourages reluctant readers to engage in the Harry Potter books and, ultimately, reading more widely.
