

We will do this by:




GLOBAL PROJECTS

India:

- Train the Trainer Intensive delivery of the Certificate IV Training and Assessment qualification (TAE) to upskill 45 Industry specialists from Tamil Nadu.
- Working with Tamil Nadu Skills Development Corporation and with Industry in India to train and facilitate the transition of suitable qualified workers into Western Australia (& Australia-wide) to fill current skill shortages. Provide transitional support and industry onboarding.
- Hosting inbound groups for a study immersion from the top 100 Universities in India. Collaborating with the four WA Universities and Industry for academic programs and delivery of tailored leadership training and cultural awareness activities.

Indonesia:

- Face-to-face and hybrid Executive Leadership Training and Coaching to organisations based in Indonesia.
- Collaborate with Indonesian Scholarship bodies including Indonesian International Student Mobility Awards (IISMA) to facilitate semester-abroad experiences for sponsored students.
- Executive Leadership program for key leaders in education from East Java. Course auspicing and gap skill analysis across multiple industry areas.





Japan:
