Protective Behaviours Workshop



The Australian Child Maltreatment Study found that 28.5% of children experienced child sexual abuse and 39.6% of children experienced exposure of family and domestic violence before the age of 18, and most will never speak about it.

At **Child Focused Safety Services** we hold a fundamental belief that all children and young people have **the right to physical**, **sexual and psychological safety at all times.** We must all play our part in protecting children and young people and one very important way to achieve this, is through education.

Whilst there is no 100% foolproof system for protecting children, the Protective Behaviours Program is a **personal safety program** that teaches children and young people age-appropriate skills and strategies to recognise and respond to a range of unsafe situations including but not limited to, child abuse and family and domestic violence.

Whilst most harm is caused to children in their homes by the people they know, children and young people are regularly involved in activities and organisations outside of the home that are provided by government, non-government and community-based organisations. Children and young people rely on the adults entrusted with their care to both protect and empower them to be safe from any form of abuse or harm. To achieve this, every organisation must embed a child safe culture across all activities and services, with leaders, staff and volunteers being vigilant in providing child safe and friendly environments, interactions and education.
