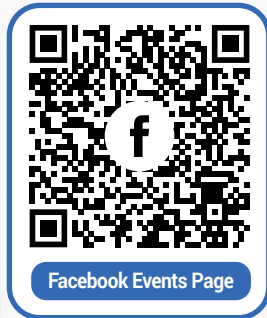


PRESS ANNOUNCEMENT

| CONTEXT AND VISION

The unknown and uncertain can be scary.

Near future is extremely difficult to predict, but it is possible to design, and is indeed worth designing.

This fear, therefore, should not lead to inaction and belief that somehow everything will get "back to normal", causing one to delusionally cling to the bygone status-quo.

Infantilism and complacency are unacceptable in difficult times of radical changes: such times require a cool mind, vision and decisive actions.

Many years of Russian imperial propaganda and narratives promoted by the "agents of influence" (bought by dirty Kremlin money) have achieved their goals - the **myths about "one and indivisible Russia" are believed by a large part of the political, diplomatic, academic and expert circles of NATO and EU countries.**

The imperial lie of the Kremlin, repeated thousands of times, **denies the right of dozens of nations** (Chechens, Kalmyks, Bashkorts, Sakhas, Buryats, Komi, Tatars, Circassians, Erzya, Karelians, Khakass, Kumyks, Chuvash, Nogai, Ingush, etc.) and colonial regions (Siberia, Urals, Pacific Coast, Kuban, Ingria, Smalandia, etc.) for their own independence and statehood (as it used to be with the Poles, Finns, Lithuanians, Ukrainians, Georgians, Latvians, Azerbaijanis, Kazakhs, etc.)

This propaganda is so effective that deceitful theses like "talk about disintegration will only consolidate the people around Putin's regime" (such a claim is not based on any evidence, moreover, there are facts that prove its opposite), "without Moscow's rule there will be a war of all against all" (at a time when **precisely imperial Muscovy is the source of conflicts, wars and instability all over the world**), "if the Russian Federation ceases to exist, nuclear weapons will spread" (in fact, it was the **Russian Federation that facilitated the spread of nuclear weapons to Belarus, North Korea and Iran**), "the PRC will primarily benefit from the collapse of Russia" (especially ironic, because the **controlled decolonization of Russia is the key to restraining Beijing's aggressive plans**) are peddled repeatedly without any evidence or objective analysis backing them.

The security and well-being of the states of the free world (Italy, Germany, the EU in general + all other liberal-democratic societies) are not possible without tectonic changes within the so-called Russian Federation.

The essence and meaning of Russian imperialism is internal repression, oppression and violence, as well as external military expansion, aggression and terrorism.

Coordinating its own actions with other hateful authoritarian & totalitarian regimes (PRC, Iran, DPRK), and controlled proxies & hybrid entities affiliated with them (Hamas, Hezbollah, ISIS, Boko Haram, Taliban, Lukashenko and Assad regimes, etc.), the **so-called Russian Federation is itself the biggest threat today.**

It should have been done a long time ago, but it is also not too late yet: **in order to eliminate the nuclear threat and prevent the start of the Third World War**, it is necessary to free the dozens of nations and regions of Northern Eurasia from the enslavement of imperial Muscovy.

The **transformation of the post-Russian space into 20-40 independent free states through the full decolonization of the last empire in Europe** is the fastest, most effective and affordable path to achieve lasting peace, which should become our common cause, the topic of daily systematic work with a specific plan, general strategy of action involving coordination and synchronization of activities.

Precisely by discussing relevant scenarios, within the scope of expert analytics and open debates, we will be able to form optimal solutions and come up with opportunities, among others, in the following areas:

Minimizing the likelihood of future migration crises, crime and terrorist threats which are currently actively utilized as weapons and means of hybrid aggression by the terrorist state Russian Federation against the free countries of the world (Italy and Germany in particular).

- **Complete denuclearization** of newly independent states of Post-Russia.
- Exchange of natural resources like **gas, oil, aluminum, gold, nickel, coal, diamonds, uranium and others – they belong to Tatars, Bashkorts, Siberians, Kalmyks, Buryats, Caucasians, Sakha etc. (not “Russia” or Moscow!)**, through direct contacts with the regions possessing them (i.e., the future independents Post-Russian states) without interference or “mediation” by the imperial Moscow.
